He is presently serving as counsel for a school district in a case involving the challenging of the lack of required funding under the Federal "No Child Left Behind Act." That case is pending before the U. S. Supreme Court. He has represented clients in numerous Federal and State Court of Appeals proceedings and many cases before the Michigan Supreme Court.

In 2009, Mr. Pollard was appointed by the Speaker of the House and Senate Majority Leader to serve on a State commission. He was one of five members appointed and on December 31, 2009 provided a report to the Governor and Legislature on the State's compliance with the Headlee Amendment to the Michigan Commission.

Mr. Pollard is a 1965 graduate of the University of Detroit where he obtained his Bachelor of Science Degree in Finance. He obtained his Juris Doctor from the University of Detroit School of Law in 1968.
